Stile & rail door construction has distinct joinery and better depth and definition. This results in crisp, clean lines that are architecturally correct. Each door is crafted by hand, ensuring a perfect fit.

### enhanced stability

Because stile & rail doors are built with separate components, the door parts can naturally contract and expand with ambient humidity changes without warping or bending. This is a significant improvement over door manufacturing that involves routing out or stamping a solid piece of wood that is prone to warping.

Mullion: narrow vertical sections

between panels

Muntin: slim vertical pieces used to

separate panes of glass

Sticking: the design of the profile edge on the

stile; ovolo is carved and rounded; shaker is straight and squared







Hardwoods such as Cherry and Oak feature exquisite grain detail and convey a warm, inviting look in darker stains. The subtle grain detail of Maple in a light stain exudes a more contemporary look. Softwoods, such as pine, have more resins and color variations and are well suited for casual interiors.

### **Wood Types & Species**

The difference between soft and hardwoods is simple – softwood comes from trees with cones and hardwood comes from trees with leaves. Wood species vary in grain color and uniformity.

### Cherry: Hardwood

One of the richer, more elegant woods with a fine uniform straight grain and texture. A popular choice for today's home.

### Clear Pine: Softwood

Natural characteristics include an indistinct grain, contrasting color and occasional sap specks, streaks and knots – ideal for a variety of interiors.

### Hemlock: Softwood

A pale brown appearance with reddish hue – hemlock's tight, wood grain pattern is sure to enhance any décor and looks great in light to dark stains.

### Knotty Alder: Hardwood

Prominent rustic markings with classic wood knots give knotty alder wood a timeless look that blends nicely in a variety of casual themed interiors.

### Knotty Pine: Softwood

An old-time favorite - the rustic appearance of knotty pine and its imperfect characteristics make it a perfect choice for a country look.

### Maple: Hardwood

Distinguished by its smooth even and fine grain, maple's light color and sleek look is increasingly popular in contemporary interiors.

### Oak: Hardwood

Classic open grain patterns and noticeable variations in oak's hearty color provide natural warmth with rich texture that coordinates beautifully with any décor.

### Poplar: Hardwood

A versatile member of the magnolia family, poplar's fine texture and grayish sapwood color with greenish brown heart is frequently finished to look like other woods.

### Radiata Pine: Softwood

A common-grade wood with light brown to chestnut brown hues that captures dark and light stains well, making it an excellent choice for modest designer budgets.

### MDF: Paint Grade

Masonite doors made of smooth MDF composite panels, stiles and rails, come factory-primed and ready to paint.





Please contact Masonite to obtain a copy of the limited warranty.

### **Door Care:**

- Doors must be stored flat and fully protected against humidity. When doors are moved, they must be lifted, eliminating any sliding of one door on another.
- In order not to change the door's balance, a maximum of 1/2" may be removed on its width (1/4" on each side). Any modification to the door's height must not exceed 1" and should be removed from the bottom rail only.
- When the door is hung, a good quality sealant must be applied immediately to minimize humidity absorption. Special attention must be given to finish all six sides of the door, including the top and bottom of the door. Doors must be finished on all sides to have a valid warranty.
